Each year, Steller conducts a health education program with a focus on healthy relationships, STI's/HIV/AIDS education, human sexuality/teen relationship issues, and safety. This program is presented to the sophomore class as a full-day workshop, which features community guest speakers.

The purpose of this day is to present students with accurate and current information on sexuality, reproductive health, and teen relationships. This year, our day includes many prevention-based presentations: Peer Outreach Workers Education & Referral (POWER) will be presenting about sexually transmitted infections as well as HIV/AIDS. Standing Together Against Rape (STAR) will be presenting on sexual assault and prevention as well as healthy/safe teen relationships. Planned Parenthood will present on human anatomy & physiology, reproductive health, and give a condom demonstration if time allows. Alaskan AIDS Assistance Association (FOUR A's) and GLBTA-Identity program will be presenting on tolerance & teen issues. All presenters focus on safe and healthy choices as well as encourage communication with families.

We feel it is very important that every sophomore attend this event. **Parent permission is required to attend this workshop.** The students will be excused from their regular classes, if they attend the full day workshop. Students without permission must attend regularly scheduled classes.

Lunch (Pizza) will be provided this year courtesy of 10th grade parents/family volunteers. Students who cannot have pizza for lunch will be expected to bring a "brown bag lunch" alternative. No one will be permitted to leave for lunch due to time constraints on the speaker schedule.
