Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Depart for Greece!

Day 2-3: Arrive in Greece and begin your tour of Athens - the cradle of Western Civilization. Visit the ancient Acropolis and see the Parthenon, the Temple of Athena, the Theatre of Dionysus, and tour the National Archaeological Museum. Climb the Lykavittos Hill for a panoramic view of Athens and the Acropolis.

Day 4: Travel to ancient Corinth to see its ancient Temple of Apollo and the remains of the Roman Agora. Climb the Acrocorinth, depending on time. In the afternoon travel to Mycenae where Agamemnon launched his campaign against Troy. Later in the day travel to our beach resort in Tolo or Naflio.

Day 5-6: Travel to the ancient Theatre of Epidaurus, one of the best preserved ancient Greek theatres in the world. Next make our way to Delphi, the place the ancient Greeks believed to be the center of the world. See the Temple of Apollo, where elected priests would interpret the oracle's cryptic prophecies to waiting supplicants. Visit the Delphi Museum to view artifacts dating back to 550 B.C. Free time for shopping and exploring in Delphi. Visit the Monastery of Osios Loukas.

Day 7: Board your ferry to the island of Santorini!

Day 8: Arrive at the volcanic crater of Santorini. Begin touring the island, visit Fira, and take a hike along the rim of the volcano.

Day 9: This morning visit the beach and then go on a biking tour of the island. Transfer to the harbor after lunch for our departure. Arrive in Athens and transfer to hotel.

Day 10: Depart for home from Athens.
