

Alaska School Counselor Scholarship 2013-2014

The Alaska School Counselor Association is pleased to present the 2013-2014 Alaska School Counselor Association Scholarship Program. Full tuition and partial tuition waivers are being offered at the Alaska Schools listed below for the post-secondary school year 2014-2015:

- Alaska Career College
 - 5 Individual \$500 tuition waivers for Allied Health Programs & 5 \$1000 tuition waivers for Business Administration, Computer and Accounting Diploma and Degree Programs.

Alaska Vocational and Technical School

• 3 tuition waivers for the Construction Trades which include Refrigeration, Carpentry, Plumbing, Heating, Industrial Electrical and also Business Technology.

University of Alaska Fairbanks

• \$2500 per semester (\$5000 total), 15 credits required each semester (full-time), maintain 3.0 GPA, non-renewable for 2015/16.

University of Alaska Anchorage

• \$2500 per semester (\$5000 total), 12 credits required, 2.5 GPA, admission to an Associates or Bachelor's program, non-renewable for 2015/16.

Alaska Pacific University

 Partial tuition waiver of \$2000 for the year, renewable up to 5 years, maintain 3.0 GPA, (needs to be admitted to a traditional undergraduate program).

Requirements

- 1. Nominations must be made by a <u>current member</u> of AkSCA *One nomination per scholarship
- 2. Applicants must be a 2013 graduate of an Alaska High School.
- 3. Successful applicants must be enrolled as a <u>full-time</u> post-secondary student for the 2013-2014 school year.

Scholarship applications MUST contain ALL of the following:

The front cover sheet MUST include:
 Applicant's full name, address, telephone number, and high school name
 Nominator's full name, school and address of, telephone number and email
School to which the applicant has applied is identified
A goal statement of the student's PERSONAL <u>and</u> EDUCATIONAL goals (500 words or less).
Three letters of recommendation: *(All letters must state recommender's name and relation to student)
One letter from the nominating CURRENT AkSCA member
One letter from someone <u>NOT</u> employed by the school district
Examples: Employment Supervisor, Clergy, Mentor, Family Friend, Legislator
One letter from an employee of the school district
Examples: Principal, Teacher from Elementary or Secondary School, Cook, Coach
An official transcript.
A list of extra-curricular activities AND service.

Selection will be based upon

- 25% Scholastic Performance
- 25% Goal Statement
- 25% Recommendations
- 25% Extra Curricular Activities and Service
