Now, to the Heart of the Matter

Here is the breakdown of costs so far (15/18/20 students):

3 plays = \$85/83.34/82.5

Rooms = \$102/100/99 (3 nights); \$1136/134.34/132 (4 nights)

Meals = \$54.4/53.34/52.8 (3 days); \$72.54/71.12/70.4 (4 days)

Workshop = \$8.34/6.95/6.25; Exploring Design = \$5.67/4.73/4.25; Backstage Tour = \$15.87/15.5/15.4

Airline Ticket, Round Trip = \$775.51/760.32/752.71 (March 2nd-5th); \$792.76/777.22/769.44 (March 1st-5th)

Total Price per student = \$1058.79/1036.18/1024.91 (3days); \$1132.18/1108.2/1096.24 (4days)
