Payments may be made with a check (written by your AA) on the day of the event or sending a request to the ASD for a school transfer (IFAS). Transfers may be made with IFAS through arrangement between your school's AA and ASD. IFAS payments should be made IN ADVANCE of the performance. Please note that IFAS payments are your BEST option with built in receipts. Due to district guidelines, we are **no longer able to accept cash** payments, or personal checks. Please contact your school's AA to process payment.

If you will be using an ASD bus to get to the performance, please schedule the bus now. Use **185006-3130** as the billing number and West High will pick up the tab. Be judicious with buses and use them ONLY to get to and from the show. Additional travel will be billed to you. Where possible, share. If you must cancel buses or tickets, you must do so AT LEAST 10 school days in advance or you will be charged for the bus or seating. There are no refunds given for tickets, so please make sure your counts are accurate.
