- Application Presentation

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

Complete applications must include the following:

- Completed and signed scholarship application form
- Essay (maximum of 2 pages)
 - Refer to page 3 of application for essay content.
- ☐ Two letters of reference
 - Letters of reference shall be from your teacher(s), guidance counselor, school administrator, employer, or volunteer organizer.
 - Reference letters must be mailed directly to the scholarship committee from the teacher, counselor, school administrator, employer or volunteer organizer.
 - Official high school transcript (no photocopies)
 - Transcript must be mailed directly to the scholarship committee by your high school in a sealed envelope.

Please be aware of the following deadlines:

February 11, 2015	Required application materials listed above are due. Applications must be postmarked by this date.
April-May, 2015	Certificates will be awarded during Senior Awards Ceremony

Letters of recommendation should touch on student's academic, leadership and communication skills, as well as their commitment, curiosity, initiative and ability to work with others.
- 2. Official school transcript mailed <u>directly</u> from your school in a sealed envelope to the scholarship committee.
