Who may attend?

Anchorage School District middle school students in grades 7 or 8 during the 2014-15 school year may take Algebra Readiness Online with teacher and counselor approval. Students in grade 8 may choose either Alg. Readiness, Astronomy, or Health Opportunities through PE.

Dates for Summer School

(last day to register for classes is May 22)
First Day of Classes June 8
Last Day of Classes July 17

How much credit may be earned?

Academic courses are worth 0.5 credit each.

How long are the classes?

Online classes start June 8th and end July 17th. Students can work on the class from anywhere they have Internet access.

What is the cost?

The cost is \$100 per enrollment. Fee waiver forms are available on ASD iSchool website.

How early do I have to wake up?

Online classes can be worked on at any time.

Grades

Final grades will be sent to the registrar at the student's home school. All grades will be available at the student's home school in mid-August. Credit for classes taken by 8th graders will be posted to the high school transcript.

What courses are available online this summer?

Algebra Readiness is available to qualified 7th and 8th graders with math teacher recommendation. Astronomy and Health Opportunities through PE (HOPE) are available to 8th graders only.

Infractions that could lead to the loss of credit and being withdrawn from summer school classes:

- Non-participation in class
- Plagiarism/ Cheating
- Inappropriate forum posts
- Violating ASD Internet Use agreement
- Abusive language
- Harassment/cyber bullying

Depending on the seriousness of the infraction, other consequences may be pursued (For example: expulsion, police involvement).

How do I register?

- 1. Fill out the registration form and print it.
- 2. A parent/guardian signature is required.
- 3. Current math teacher signature is required for Algebra Readiness.
- 4. Pay \$100 per course either online in Parent Connect under your home school or take a check or money order to your school's Financial Clerk (FDCC). Make checks and money orders payable to *Anchorage School District*. The FDCC will mark the receipt number in the upper right corner of the form.
- 5. Take either your online payment receipt or the receipt from the FDCC when meeting with your counselor to go over your completed registration form.
- 6. Counselors will collect the form and review for completeness before sending it to ASD iSchool (no later than May 22rd).

Note – The last day to register for an online class is May 22rd. Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If you wait until the last day to register, you may not be able to enroll in the class that you need; the class may be full. Classes are subject to consolidation or cancellation due to low enrollment.

How do I get started?

Login information will be posted on the ASD iSchool website. Students are responsible to start working in the class on June 8th. Students having login issues should email asdischool@asdk12.org on June 9th to get assistance.
