

This is a course designed for students that are interested in working or traveling in remote areas of Alaska. We will be studying emergency responses in remote scenarios. Special wilderness topics include: wound management and infection, managing fractures and dislocations, improvised splinting, selective spine immobilization, patient monitoring, long term management problems and up-to-date information on all environmental emergencies. Emphasis is placed on treatment principles and decision making. This course will take place in Talkeetna where we will spend half of our time inside and half outside role-playing scenarios to prepare students for real world situations. Students will be staying in cabins for the duration of the intensive learning basic cooking skills and sharing time with their peers.
