STANDARDIZED TESTING SCHEDULE AT STELLER 2016

There was a typo on the previous testing schedule. 11th graders are not participating in AMP testing. They are doing the ACT only.

The standardized testing season is right around the corner. The district is offering the ACT (American College Testing) for 11^{th} graders and the AMP (Alaska Measures of Progress) for grades 7^{th} through 10^{th} .

ACT

March 1 – 8:30 to approximately 1:30 in the MPR

- Cell phones or electronic devices other than approved calculators are not allowed
- Eating and drinking not allowed in the test room (students can snack and drink outside the test room during break)
- No books, dictionaries, or scratch paper allowed in the test room
- Only Number 2 pencils allowed (no highlighters, etc.)
- Approved calculators
- Assigned seats

We ask students to please arrive early to school so they are seated in the MPR by 8:30. Students arriving late will not be allowed into the test room.
