JBER Spouses' Club Scholarship Guidelines

Eligibility: Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, the son or daughter of an active duty or retired active duty member. Rank is not a consideration. The active duty military member and/or family must live in the Anchorage area. The Anchorage area is considered to be from Wasilla/Palmer to Girdwood. This includes students whose parents are divorced. A student living with a parent who has married a military member, who provides support, even if not adopted by the service member, is also eligible. Applicants must have a current military ID card, must be a US citizen, and have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA.

Selection Criteria: Selection of recipients is based upon scholarship, leadership, and citizenship. Our goal is to choose students who are recognized as well-rounded individuals. A scholarship criterion includes the essay portion of the application, GPA, SAT/ACT score, difficulty and variety of classes, as well as Honors and Advanced placement classes. Activities in and out of school will be taken into consideration, such as offices held, honors, awards, work experience, etc.

While need is not considered in the selection process, a recipient may not also accept a four year full tuition scholarship or an appointment to a service academy. This will forfeit the scholarship and it will be awarded to a selected alternate.

Each recipient is responsible for providing JSC with the name and financial aid office address of his/her chosen college. Upon notification, the JSC will mail a check directly to the school on behalf of the student.

The scholarship may not carry over into another year and is only for the first year of college. Any funds not used are forfeited and must be returned to the JSC.

Deadline: All applications must be received by **February 28, 2017 at 5:00pm** to be considered for selection. Please allow time for mailing applications to reach the JSC by the deadline. Late submissions will not be accepted.

The JBER Spouses' Club (JSC) will be awarding several scholarships this year. Please read the scholarship guidelines to determine eligibility. Interested students are required to complete the attached application and return it to the JSC by **February 28, 2017 at 5:00pm**. Please allow enough mailing time for the packet to reach the JSC by February 28, 2017, as this is a received by deadline, not a postmark deadline. Applications may be hand delivered to The Bargain Shop, 8515 Saville Avenue, Elmendorf on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Friday from 10:00am - 2:00pm. Late submissions will not be accepted.

If you are selected for the scholarship you will be notified by telephone and by mail within a few days of the selection. Students not selected will also receive a letter notifying them of the results. We will present scholarships at an award reception hosted by the JSC tentatively scheduled for the evening of Thursday, March 23rd, 2017.

All paperwork must be submitted together and sent to JSC as a complete package. Application form, scholarship guidelines, and checklist form have been sent to high school counselors and should be available soon online at www.jberspousesclub.com. Package must include:

- Checklist
- Complete application form (no hand written forms allowed)
- Official transcript with registrar's seal affixed
- Copy of SAT/ACT result signed by counselor
- Copy of Military ID Card
