Get organized

- \rightarrow Gather your high school transcript, be sure they remain in a sealed envelope
- \rightarrow Ask teachers/supervisors for letters of recommendation
- → Prepare to apply for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)-see below

• File for the FAFSA

- \rightarrow You will need the following information to apply:
 - ✓ FSA ID
 - ✓ Social Security Number
 - ✓ Driver's License Number
 - ✓ 2017 Tax Records (For school year 2019/2020)
 - ✓ Records of untaxed income
 - ✓ Records of assets (money)
 - ✓ List(s) of the schools you're interested in attending
- Research open dates for scholarships at The Alaska Community Foundation, Alaska Native Foundations and even opportunities out of State. You can also ask your friends and family if they know of scholarships to apply for.
- Review requirements and gather information
- Draft your essay
 - \rightarrow Have others read over it and edit.
- Apply for the scholarships you are eligible for!
- Celebrate your progress and potential awards!
