LEARN TO KNIT, CROCHET & FELT

Week 1:

- 1. needle felting small objects
- 2. mechanical felting decorative object accessories
- 3. crochet a comforter or scarf etc.

Week 2:

- 1. knit a scarf basic technique or challenge yourself with more complicated techniques.
- 2. (time permitting) knit a wool hat to felt and decorate with week 1 felted objects.

Credit: .25 elective

Cost: \$80 (give or take \$15) less if no time for wool hats

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
