SCHOLARSHIPS FOR OCTOBER, NOVEMBER & DECEMBER

1) Voice of Democracy Scholarship - \$30,000 - 50 Awards (Deadline: October 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Currently be in high school between the grades 9-12.
- B) Be enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school or home study program in the United States.

2) KidGuard High School Scholarship - \$800 - 3 Awards (Deadline: October 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior enrolled in any school in the United States.
- B) Submit an essay answering one of the 2019 prompt questions.

3) Magnum Opus Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 31, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

4) Real World Design Challenge Scholarships - \$50,000 – 7 Awards (Deadline: November 22, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be currently enrolled in grade nine, ten, eleven or twelve. Students enrolled in school environments with alternative grade or level designations must be engaged in a program of study equivalent to the corresponding high school grade level.

5) YDI Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 29, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.

B) Be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.

6) Griswold Home Care Scholarship - \$1,000 - 2 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as full-time undergraduate students, in an accredited institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrate a verifiable need for financial support.

B) Have at least one parent of Hispanic ancestry

9) SP Scholarship - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:
