Alaska Crossings is a short term intensive behavioral health program dedicated to helping youth learn and develop skills they need to succeed. We believe that combining therapeutic interventions with outdoor and expeditionary activities provides a powerful catalyst for engaging in the process of change. With this belief in mind we run programs for Alaskan youth ages 12–18. Throughout the duration of the program the groups run on an expedition model in the Tongass National Forest, the Stikine River, and the mountains in the surrounding areas.

Youth who can benefit from Alaska Crossings during the school year include those who have been suspended, are failing classes, or are truant due to emotional and behavioral issues

Alaska Crossings works with struggling youth to develop individualized coping and behavior management skills that support successful integration back into the school setting upon their return home.



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
